7 January

150 years of Postal History - three-stamp mini-sheet. Two postal related anniversaries in 2021: the 150th anniversary of the Danish Postal Service's Postal Act of 7.01.1871, when the Faroe Islands became a part of the Danish postal area and the 45th anniversary of the Faroe Islands' takeover of the Faroese branch of the Danish postal administration. Design: Kári við Rættará. Values: 3 x 17,00 DKK. FO 942-943.



19 February

Transplanted - immigration stories - six-stamp mini-sheet and two posters. Joel Cole, a Faroese American, celebrates the immigrant experience, both as a universal element of the human story and through the particulars of his own life. Design: Joel Cole. Values: 3 x 5,00 DKK and 3 x 17,00 DKK. FO 945-950.



Villages: Kirkja & Hattarvík - two stamps, a self-adhesive booklet with six stamps and two postcards. Both settlements on Fugloy island are quite old, but while Hattarvík is the original name of the settlement, the name of Kirkja dates back to more recent times. Photos: Fotostudio. The Eysturoy Tunnel, an Underwater Roundabout - two stamps. The subsea "Eysturoy Tunnel" opened officially on 19th December 2020. The tunnel which is 11 kilometres long connects the islands of Streymoy and Eysturoy. The roundabout artwork was designed by local artist Tróndur Patursson. Andrea Ártung - one stamp. Andrea Ártung was chair-woman of the Tórshavn's Working Women's Association for 40 years. The matter closest to Andrea's heart was to achieve "equal pay for equal work". Artist: Anker Eli Petersen. Value: 39,00 DKK. FO 955.

Sepac 2021: The Faroes on Historical Maps II - one-stamp mini-sheet. Design: Kim Simonsen. Value: 27,00 DKK. FO 956.

Europa 2021: Endangered National Wildlife, the Atlantic Puffin - two stamps, a self-adhesive booklet with six stamps and two postcards. Photos: Thomas Vikre and Jógvan Hansen. Values: 17,00 and 27,00 DKK. FO 957-958.



Cattle - three stamps. Until the 1970s, many Faroese families had a cow in the basement. Artist: Ole Wich. Value: 7,00, 10,00 and 17,00 DKK. FO 959-961.

C. Z. Slania 100 Years - one-stamp mini-sheet. The Polish-born Swedish court engraver Czeslaw Slania was born in 1921. He engraved 100 Faroese stamps. Artist/engraver: Martin Mörrck. Value: 39,00 DKK.



27 September

SALT - two-stamp mini-sheet. The old salt silo from 1938 has been renovated and rebuilt for the cultural center SALT - Sound Art & Live Theater. Photos: Fotostudio. Values: 17,00 and 39,00 DKK.

Royal Visit in the Faroe Islands in 1921 - two stamps. In 1921 King Christian X visited the Faroe Islands. Photos: Old postcards. Values: 2 x 17,00 DKK.



Christmas Stamps: Bishop's Robes - two stamps, a self-adhesive booklet with six stamps and two postcards. The third and final issue in the series of church paraments. Values: 17,00 and 27,00 DKK.
